



#### **Cantilever Box**




# **COMPONENTS**

#### **Base Plate Box**




### If Applicable | Add-on Base Plate Box



### INSTALLATION

#### Step 1

Remove Cantilever and components from box. Be sure all packaging has been removed from around your umbrella.




### Step 2

Remove Bottom Base Plate completely from packaging and place in the desired location, with the rubber feet touching the ground.


#### **WARNING**

Each base plate weighs approximately **175 lbs**. and it is highly recommended that **4 people** are used to lift and move each plate to avoid injury.



### Step 3


Remove Upper Base Plate completely from packaging and place on top of the Bottom Base Plate with the holes in the middle of each plate aligned.


### Step 4

Once the 4 center holes of the top plate are aligned above the 4 center holes of the bottom plate, you will place the base tube on top of the holes. Use the bolts and washers to firmly attach the base tube to the base plates.


#### Step 6

Place your Cantilever on top of the base tube.

#### **WARNING: TEAM LIFT**


Use 2 people to lift and place cantilever in to ...

#### Step 7


Once you have found the ideal angle and direction for the canopy, push in the **lower latch** until it locks into place.



Push latch to lock

Pull ring to unlock

Please note: the Cantilever will only lock into the Base Tube in one of 12 positions (shown here).



# **OPERATION** Opening Instructions


#### Step 1

Place your Crank Key in to the hole in the side of your Cantilever. Maintain inward pressure when turning the Crank Key to ensure it remains consistently engaged, when cranking.



#### Step 2

Apply moderate inward pressure to the Crank Key while cranking the key counter clockwise until the Cantilever is in the fully raised and still closed position, and the upper latch has locked into place.



#### **WARNING**


Do not let go of the Crank Key during any part of this action, until the latch has locked into place in its fully upright position. Letting go of the Crank Key may result in the Crank Key quickly spinning backward which can cause damage to your cantilever or injury to the operator.



# **OPERATION** Opening Instructions

### Step 3

Once the upper latch has locked into place, you may now crank the Crank Key clockwise to begin opening your Cantilever.




#### **Step 4 - OPTIONAL**

You may remove your Crank Key from the Cantilever hole to prevent unauthorized use and for secure keeping. If you choose to do this, be sure you remember where you place the Crank Key. The umbrella cannot be operated without it. *Trying to operate the Cantilever with tools or foreign objects may damage your Cantilever and void the warranty.* 

# **OPERATION** Closing Instructions

### Step 1


Place your Crank Key in to the hole in the side of your Cantilever.



#### Step 2

Apply moderate inward pressure to the Crank Key while cranking the key counterclockwise until the Cantilever is in the fully closed position.


Note your Cantilever is now in **Closed Upright Position**, although it is safe to leave in this position when not in use. It is recommended that it be placed in the **Closed Shortened Position** for safest stroage, and when the item will remain unused for a prolonged period of time. Please follow the following instructions to lower your Cantilever into the **Closed Shortened Position**.



# **OPERATION** Closing Instructions

#### Step3


With your hand firmly grasping the Crank Key, pull the pin at the base of the **upper latch** your other hand. While placing inward pressure on the Crank Key, crank it clockwise until the Cantilever is in the fully Closed Shortened Position.



#### **WARNING**

Do not let go of the Crank Key during any part of this action, until the Cantilever is in the fully Closed Shortened Position. Letting go of the Crank Key at any time may result in the Crank Key quickly spinning which can cause damage to your cantilever or injury to the operator.





Please Note: Your Cantilever should now be in the Closed Shortened Position. To further secure your Cantilever when not in use, place the Wind Tie around the frame and canopy while in the Closed Shortened Position. Connect the Velcro strips to hold it in place.

Note: To open your Cantilever again, simply follow the Opening Instructions again.
