

COVER GUIDE & CARE

To safeguard outdoor furniture from the elements, it is advised to cover them while not in use. Prior to installing protective covers, ensure that furniture surfaces are clean as mold and mildew can grow on damp surfaces as well as organic foreign substances. Read all instructions to learn how to keep your covers and furniture protected.

PROTECTING YOUR COVER:

To add a layer of protection against oil and water-based stains apply a coating of Pacifica Preserve and Protect Fabric Defense to your protective cover. (Note that this solution should also be applied directly to all of your upholstered outdoor furniture as long as the materials are made of; cotton, polyester, nylon and other cotton blends)



Pacifica: Preserve and Protect Fabric Defense

Notes before Protector application:

- One application is sufficient to restore water repellency.
- It is recommended to treat your fabrics with this protector once a year for the best defense.
- Horizontal areas of fabrics with a lot of outdoor exposure should be treated twice a year.

Prepare to apply Protector spray by covering the work area with a fabric or plastic tarp. Please make sure it is an open space with plenty ventilation and make sure to wear protective eyewear and gloves.

Once area has been setup proceed with the following steps:

- Step 1: Make sure your fabric is clean before spraying. If cleaning is necessary, follow the instructions located in “How to clean your protective cover”.
- Step 2: Properly shake the bottle of Protector before use. Hold the spray 12-14 inches from fabric surface and evenly spray until area is completely soaked.
- Step 3: Allow it to dry for 24 hours.
- Step 4: Reinstall cover.

GENERAL CARE FOR YOUR PROTECTIVE COVER

- To avoid mold and mildew growth regularly brush or shake cover to rid of debris and any water that has pooled.
- Regularly rinse cover with water hose. Lay flat to dry and do not reinstall, until the cover is completely dry. For ongoing care, it is recommended you do this at least once a month.

HOW TO CLEAN YOUR PROTECTIVE COVE

A thorough cleaning is necessary at least once a year for both your cover and your outdoor furniture. Follow proper cleaning instructions below for covers and follow provided manufacturer instructions for outdoor furniture:

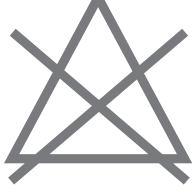
- Step 1: Create a mixture of mild soap such as Dawn® and water (1/4 cup of mild soap per gallon of water) and spray evenly on your protective cover.
- Step 2: Scrub your cover with either a soft bristle brush/or a sponge.
- Step 3: Rinse thoroughly until soap residue is removed.
- Step 4: Air dry, do not reinstall until the cover is completely dry.



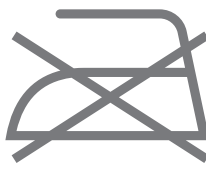
Hand wash

Do not bleach

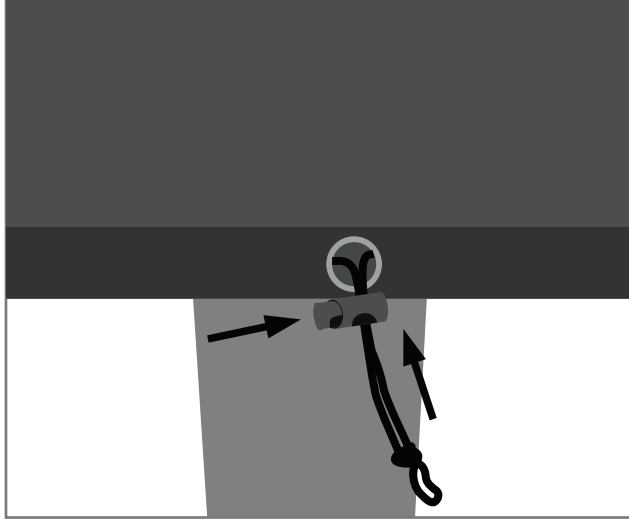
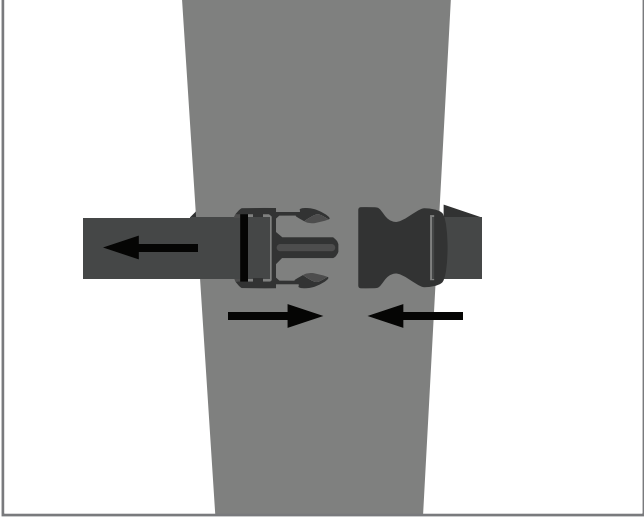


Do not iron

HOW TO INSTALL YOUR COVER

Note: If furniture has cushions, either store separately or make sure they are laying flat on your furniture piece.

1. Remove cover from packaging and extend. Locate the front and back if this applies to your cover.
2. Lay cover over your furniture piece and align.
3. Extend cover over all sides of your furniture piece.
4. If cover has buckle straps, secure buckle straps to feet of the furniture piece. Tighten straps.



5. If cover has a drawcord tighten at this time. Make sure the cover goes over the furniture feet. Once complete, securely tuck the excess drawstring cord under your cover.

HOW TO REMOVE YOUR COVER

1. Release drawcord if it applies to your cover.
2. Unsnap buckles if it applies to your cover.
3. Use handles to remove cover by pulling upwards and away from your furniture piece. This may be a two- person job if you are removing a larger protective cover.



WARNINGS

- It is recommended to always store outdoor furniture or utilize suitable furniture covers during severe weather conditions, and periods of non-use.
- Please wait for appliances such as fire pits and BBQ grills to cool before covering. It is recommended to wait a minimum of 30 minutes.
- When water has pooled on cover, remove carefully as weight can cause rips and tears on your cover. Scooping or pumping some of the water before shaking or extending fabric is recommended.
- In order to protect your cover from windy conditions please make sure cover is installed properly. Please review installation instructions.
 - Once drawstring is tightened it is recommended that you securely tuck or tie remaining cord underneath your cover as this can be a tripping hazard.
- The user should avoid placing excessive amounts of furnishings under the cover, which may form unintended points of pressure onto the cover or result in insufficient coverage or protection from the elements.
 - Do not use protective covers as a shelter for people or animals.
- This product is not for commercial use and is intended for residential use only.
